PROGRAM CLUSTER DATA COLLECTION**



PROGRAM CLUSTER: Teen Risk Behaviors

COMMON PURPOSE: Educating teens and/or preteens on teen risk behaviors and improving their decision making skills.

SHARED OUTPUT/UNIT OF SERVICE: Total number of educational interventions.

METHOD FOR CALCULATION: Every time a teen or preteen receives an intervention, count them once. For instance, if your volunteer/staff gives a 30 minute presentation to 20 children. You count that as 20 units. If your volunteer/staff presents a 45 minute interactive workshop to 10 kids, you count that as 10 units.

SHARED OUTCOME: Percentage of clients who self-report avoiding a behavior or changing a behavior as a result of the program/intervention.

METHOD FOR CALCULATION: Randomly select at least 5% of your intervention population and administer a written questionnaire that inquires about the program's impact on avoidance of or change in a teen risk behavior. This questionnaire may be administered immediately following an intervention. The data should be reported in the following manner "XX% of program participants report that our program reduced the likelihood that they would consume alcohol (insert the appropriate risk behavior)."
